1. Attach the Table Bracket

Align the Table Bracket with the pilot holes in the worksurface and drive (7) screws to secure it in place. Be sure to leave the square hole empty.



#10 X 1" Torx Head Screw (0002147)





2. Drive Screws Into Screen

Drive (2) screws into the second lowest set of holes on the Screen until there is 1/8" gap between the screw head and the Screen.






4 Secure Screen to Table Bracket

Slide the Screen onto the Table Bracket by aligning the (2) screw heads with the keyslots in the bracket. Lower the Screen until it is fully seated in the keyslots.




5. Attach Wire Management Clip

Align the wire management clip with the square hole in the Table Bracket. Then drive the screw through the wire management clip until secure




6 (Optional) Connect Power to Table Bracket

Situate the power unit in the associated power bracket. Slide the assembly on the included studs on the side of the Table Bracket. Thread a nut on each stud to secure the unit in place.




7. (Optional) Attach Monitor Mount

Align the Monitor Mount with the holes in the Screen and secure it with (4) screws. The additional holes can be used to raise or lower the Monitor. Attach the Monitor brackets to the back of the Monitor using the provided Monitor mount hardware. The additional holes in the brackets can be used to adjust the height of the Monitor. Plug in the power cable and any additional data cables to the Monitor.



8 (Optional) Mount Monitor to screen

Hang the Monitor/bracket assembly on the Monitor mount and route cables down through the elastic cording.



9 (Optional) Lock TV to screen

Slide the Lock Bar through the Monitor Mount and through both Monitor brackets. Place a lock through the hole in the end of the lock bar. (Monitor not shown for visibility)
